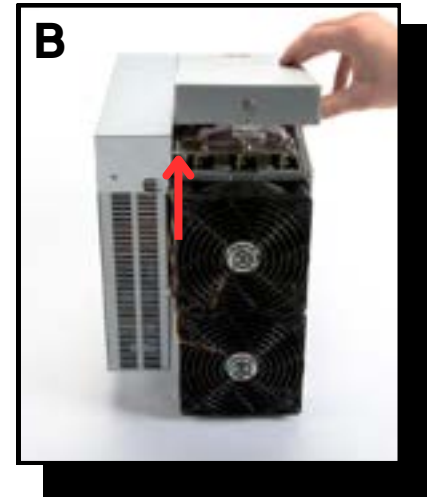


1 First, remove the cover on the control board. Remove the screws as shown in Figure A, hold down the round button, and lift the upper cover to remove it as shown in Figure B.



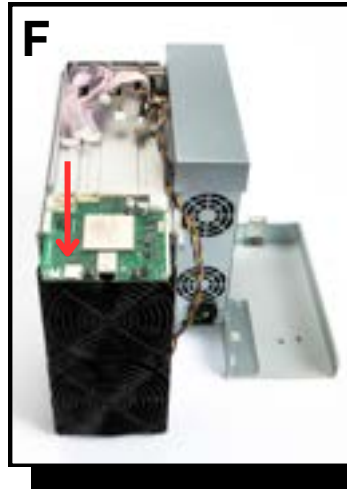
2 Remove the control board's front bezel by removing the two screws as shown in Figure C.

3 Unplug all cables, including the hashboard cable, fan cable, control board power supply cable, and power voltage regulator cable as shown in Figures D and E.

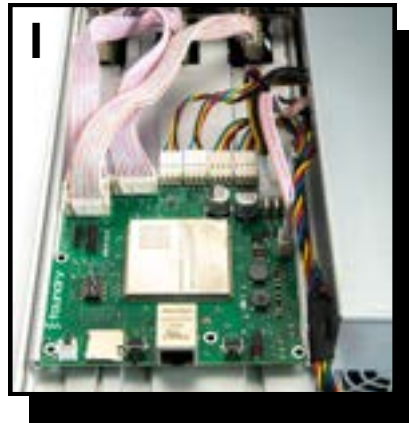


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4 The fourth step is to push the control board forward and remove from aluminum case as shown in Figures F and G.



5 Finally, follow the above instructions in reverse. Replace the control board and attach the cables as shown in Figures H and I. Then, replace the front bezel and top cover to complete the installation.



Your Foundry Control Board is now installed!
